

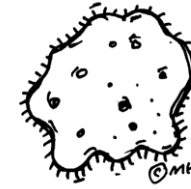


As part of our **Science Safety: Rules and Tools** unit, we made Glitter Slime! We practiced listening, following directions, using science tools (like measuring cups) and following the rules on our **Science Safety Contract**.

Here's how my slime looked:

You can make Glitter Slime at Home!

Supplies:

- ½ cup Elmer's glue
- 1 teaspoon Borax powder
- 1 ½ cups water
- Food coloring, Glitter

Directions:

1. In a small bowl, mix 1 cup of water with one teaspoon of Borax powder.
2. In a medium bowl, mix ½ cup of glue with ½ cup of water.
3. Add 4 drops of food coloring to the medium bowl and stir well.
4. Add a bunch of glitter to the medium bowl and stir well.
5. Add the Borax mixture in the small bowl to the glue and glitter mixture. It should begin to solidify!
6. Squeeze and mix it up with your hands.
7. Pour out the extra water.
8. Store in an air tight container.

Remember to be Safe! Ask an adult for help. Do not put the slime or any of the ingredients in your mouth!
